RESOLUTION NUMBER 10 OF 2019**

RESOLUTION FOR PLAN REVISION

RESOLUTION OF THE SUPERVISORS OF WILLISTOWN TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter “the municipality”).

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the “Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act,” as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, The Municipality has prepared a report titled, “Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Special Study for West Chester Pike Needs Area,” which provides for sewage facilities in a portion of Willistown Township, and the Sewage disposal alternative to be implemented is:

- Construction of a public sanitary sewer extension connected to Willistown Chase and the Penns Preserve Treatment Plant

Implementation of the sewage disposal alternative is scheduled to be complete by December 2019.


The estimated cost to implement the selected sewage disposal alternatives is \$230,558.00. The project will be funded by existing capital accounts of the Willistown Township and properties served by the project will be responsible for payment of the project costs. Estimated monthly costs per EDU are \$299 for debt service and \$61 for operating and maintenance for a total monthly cost of \$360.

WHEREAS, Willistown Township finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of the Township of Willistown hereby adopts and submits to the Department of Environmental Resources for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).


