
Temporary Overflow Parking Notice

The one hundred and eighty acre [Okehocking Preserve](#) continues to be a popular spot to get outside and enjoy the beauty of Willistown. Please use the temporary overflow parking area at Okehocking Preserve only when both the Route 3 and Delchester parking lots are full.

Recycling Reminders

A few reminders from our Recycling Commission:

- 1) Always break up cardboard boxes to lie flat before recycling
- 2) Rule for recycling plastic or metal lids: if they are less than 2" in diameter, throw them out. If they are larger, recycle them
- 3) Never put recyclables in plastic bags! The bags clog the recycling mechanism and the whole operation has to shut down while sanitation workers risk their safety to climb onto the belt and remove the plastic.



Dog License Reminder
