

# Willistown Recycling Commission Meeting

1. Single Waste/Recycling Hauler

JT brought copies of waste and recycling ordinances of five Chester County townships. One is very similar to that of Willistown; others contain some provisions that are not included in the current ordinance of Willistown. The objective is to update Willistown's current ordinance. JT is aiming to provide a rough draft at the 2/12/13 meeting.

2. Bulk Pick Ups

Allied Waste/Republic Services and AJB now have bulk pick-up programs. JT will send information to the township's web site for posting and will describe this service in the second issue of 2013 of the Willistown Town Crier.

3. Hauler Notification Letter

Some of the township's haulers are not conforming to township and possibly PADEP regulations. A letter from the township manager describing such needs to be sent to each hauler working in the township. JT will discuss with Dave Burman, Township Manager.

4. Commercial Accounts Notification Letter

A drive around the township to observe dumpster facilities for office buildings and free-standing businesses indicates that many landlords and business owners are not following recycling regulations of the township and possibly PADEP. JT will discuss with Dave Burman, Township Manager.
