I. Annual Drop-off Recycling Report – CSR (scrap metal)

Total weight: 27,960 lbs. Total value and net income to the township: \$1,297.51.

Expenses include the costs for use of dumpsters, a fuel surcharge and the removal of Freon from 19 refrigerators/freezers, air conditioners and a dehumidifier. In 2014, we will strive to schedule an issue of a newsletter with copy about this annual event to arrive about two to three weeks prior to the event. It is JT's belief that publicizing a recycling event in *Towne Crier* two months prior to the event is much too early. This results in lower participation.

II. Chipping and Shredding

Despite having to do both operations on the Willistown property instead of chipping at 688 Sugartown and shredding at 689, both operations ran smoothly. Attendance appeared to be down. Rapid Recycling's invoice/tonnage figure should be available no later than 5/31.
