RESOLUTION NUMBER 15 OF 2025

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COLLECTION OF CERTAIN
MUNICIPAL TAXES BY THE CHESTER COUNTY TREASURER**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the legal authority of 72 P.S. § 5511.22, the governing body of a municipality located within the County of Chester, a Third-Class County (hereinafter “County”), may enter into an agreement deputizing and authorizing a deputy tax collector to receive and collect certain taxes levied by the municipality (hereinafter “Services”); and

WHEREAS, the Willistown Township Tax Collector, signed an affidavit deputizing the Chester County Treasurer, Patricia Maisano and the County Treasurer’s Office, to serve as deputy tax collector and to ensure proper receipt and collection of all real estate taxes due, either directly or by contract with a third party, pursuant to 72 P.S. § 5511.22; and


WHEREAS, the County and Willistown Township have memorialized all the terms and conditions of these Services in an Agreement for Property Tax Collection Services dated January 10, 2024 (hereinafter “Agreement”), and


WHEREAS, Willistown Township, Pennsylvania, seeks to extend that Agreement and has requested that the County Treasurer’s Office to collect Willistown Township’s Real Estate Taxes commencing January 1, 2026, for a one (1) year term ending December 31, 2026;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors for Willistown Township hereby authorizes the extension of the Agreement by one additional year, through the end of December 31, 2026, and hereby continues to authorize the Chester County Treasurer to commence collection of Willistown Township Real Estate Taxes consistent with the terms and conditions set forth herein and as more fully set forth in the Agreement.


