RESOLUTION 5 OF 2014

**A RESOLUTION FOR MINOR ACT 537
UPDATE PLAN REVISION**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted there under, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, Carroll Engineering Corporation has prepared the East King Street and Tendler Lane Minor Act 537 Update Revision which provides for sewage facilities in a portion of Willistown Township, and the alternative of choice to be implemented is connecting seven (7) existing properties along East King Street and Tendler Lane to existing lateral stubs on existing 1 ½" pressure sewer. The key implementation activities/dates include: the installation of public sewers for this project has been approved by the Department and completed by 237 East King Partners but, for reasons unbeknownst to the Township, failed to include approval for connection of the remaining seven (7) properties.

WHEREAS, Willistown Township finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Willistown Township hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).


