RESOLUTION 6 OF 2014

**A RESOLUTION FOR MINOR ACT 537
UPDATE PLAN REVISION**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted there under, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, Carroll Engineering Corporation has prepared the Horseshoe Lane Sewer Extension Minor Act 537 Update Revision which provides for sewage facilities in a portion of Willistown Township, and the alternative of choice to be implemented is the installation of 1,150 LF of pressure sewer along Horseshoe Lane. While only one property will be connecting initially, the main will be sized to allow for the future connection of fifteen (15) additional properties along Horseshoe and Brook Lanes. The key implementation activities/dates include: the installation will be completed by a private property owner with completion expected in mid-2014.

WHEREAS, Willistown Township finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Willistown Township hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).


