

Willistown Recycling Committee Minutes of May 13, 2014, Meeting

1. April 12th Annual Recycling Drop-off Event

- a. 39,697 pounds of e-waste were collected. This is a considerable increase over 2013.
- b. 23,680 pounds of any item made of 100% metal or partially made of metal were collected. This is a modest decline from 2013.
- c. 927 feet of fluorescent bulbs were collected, along with 62 incandescent bulbs.
- d. The weight of tires is not yet available.

The total tonnage of e-waste and metal – 63,377—is about average for this annual event. Most outside observers in the “recycling community” think the weight is phenomenal for a township of Willistown’s size.

2. April 27th Drug Take Back Program

It was the police department’s first time in participating in this event and it was very successful. Seven large cartons of drugs, predominantly prescription drugs, were collected and incinerated.
