WHEREAS, the volunteer firefighters of the Newtown Square Fire Company serve selflessly and tirelessly in order to protect their fellow citizens; and


WHEREAS, in times of uncertainty, their commitment and heroics are immeasurable; and

RESOLVED and ADOPTED this 23rd day of May, 2016.


