

**WILLISTOWN TOWNSHIP
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 133 OF THE CODE OF WILLISTOWN TOWNSHIP REDUCING SPEED LIMITS FROM 35 MPH TO 25 MPH ON GRUBB ROAD IN BOTH DIRECTIONS FROM KING ROAD TO DEVON ROAD, AND BY PROHIBITING LEFT TURNS FROM DUTTON MILL ROAD NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND ONTO WEST CHESTER PIKE. EFFECTIVE FIVE DAYS FROM ENACTMENT.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Willistown, Pennsylvania ("Township"):

Section 1. Chapter 133, §133-7 of the Code of Willistown Township (the "Code") is amended by reducing the speed limit to 25 mph for Grubb Road between King Road and Devon Road. The existing speed limit of 35 mph for Grubb Road between Devon Road and Davis Road shall remain unchanged.


Section 2. Chapter 133, §133-9 of the Code is amended by adding the following prohibition:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>	<u>Prohibited Turn</u>	<u>At Intersection of</u>
Dutton Mill Road	North	Left	West Chester Pike
Dutton Mill Road	South	Left	West Chester Pike

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective five days from the date of enactment.
