

For those logging in with digital devices, there are two ways to participate when the meeting is opened to public comment and questions:

1. Via the **Q&A button** or audibly using the "**raise hand**" option. If you choose to use the Q&A option, we may read your question aloud if its deemed appropriate for the discussion at hand. If you want to comment audibly, select the "raise your hand" button. If you are selected to comment, we will state your name and un-mute you so you can speak. Briefly state your name, address, and item of concern, etc.



2. If you are calling in from a land-line phone, you will not get a Q&A option but can participate audibly. **Press \*9 to "raise your hand."** We will acknowledge your number verbally and then un-mute you. Briefly state your name, address, and item of concern, etc.

For all audible participants, please make sure that you do so in a quiet area, so there are no distracting sounds in the background. Also, we reserve the right to mute/remove any unruly or unintelligible attendees.
