REGISTRATION FOR THE 2022 CLEANUP WILL BE OPEN AT THE END OF FEBRUARY.

Last year, more than 800 volunteers fanned out to over thirty different sites in Chester, Ridley and Crum creeks, ridding our watersheds of debris that ranged from a trampoline to an engine block, totaling more than 10 tons of trash. Under the supervision of CRC Site Coordinators, volunteers waded through streams, help tow large items out of the water, and pick up debris along streambeds. Stream Cleanup volunteers represent individuals, organizations and clubs and all age groups, from children to senior citizens.

CRC is seeing long term positive results from this yearly event, with volunteers reporting that sites seem cleaner year after year. It stands to reason that when areas are relatively free of trash, people are less likely to dump items. Please join us and help to keep our watersheds clean – and have fun while doing it!
